A Tiffany special meeting was held on January 10th about replacing some of the park playground equipment. The equipment to be replaced is the larger west structure that is falling apart and unsafe. The vote passed. The approximately \$53,000 price tag will come from the reserve funds so there is no dues increase. We can anticipate the new equipment to be installed this year.

At this point, we are working through installation details, color choices, etc. In the course of debating the structure, a meeting was requested to get updates as to where we are in the process. We will be scheduling that update in the near future, but do not currently have enough answers to conduct such
